Ahoj! Volám sa Martin!

New Rotary Exchange Student Hails from Slovak Republic



It might suggest a pirate in need of Spellchecker; but it's indeed pronounced like "ahoy", and the above phrase would be a common greeting back home for Orrville Rotary's newest exchange student. 17-Year old Martin Michál arrived in Orrville Saturday August 16, just in time to begin a whirlwind introduction to his new adopted hometown. Michál is Orrville Rotary's first exchange student from eastern Europe, and it's appropriate that he lists running among his interests; because that's definitely how he hit the ground. Within 24 hours he was meeting future OHS classmates at a special get-together organized by Bruce, Carol, and Stacey Ubelhart, trying out his cautious English on new friends and host family members, and pitching a game or two of cornhole. One day later he was registering for classes, and the following day he entered Orrville High School as a junior. Imagine your first day in a new school... now imagine it with everyone talking rapidly in a language you've mostly encountered

on paper! Martin's generous smile survived intact, however; his luggage arrived (a day late); and he's been busy making himself at home with the Darrin Wasniewski family on East Oak St.

Wasniewski is himself no stranger to busy schedules. He serves as Main Street Orrville's executive director while his wife Stephanie is a financial aid specialist working part time at Akron Childrens' Medical Center. As if life wasn't exciting enough, they've added Martin to their household of 3 children: Ashton (5), Cora (3), and Grayson (1)! That might sound like a tall order; but ask Wasniewski about the experience (their first) of welcoming an exchange student into their lives, and he lights up with enthusiasm. "It's been amazing...the kids are learning Slovak phrases easily, and they've taken instantly to their new big brother!" Martin is a middle child back home, with both an older and a younger sister. The son of two veterinarians, he is also the second in his family to try youth exchange; older sister Elena spent last year in Charlotte, N.C. as an exchange student. Michál's English has already grown more confident, and Wasniewski is surprised at what they've all learned already about Slovak culture. "For instance, in Slovakia the given names correspond to days of the calendar," he explains, "so you celebrate not only your birthday, but also your menini or 'name day' with presents and parties." This traditional custom is actually based on the original Roman Catholic calendar of Saint's Days. For those who keep track, Martin's name day is November 11. At this pace, he'll be a full-fledged Red Rider by then-- and our world will have grown a little bit smaller and friendlier, as it always has, one Rotary exchange student at a time. Now that's worth celebrating.
