## Record Turnout for 5K Race/ Walk! 144 participate in Firecracker 5K



The annual Orrville Rotary's Firecracker 5K Race and one mile fun walk was held July 4th at the Orrville High School parking lot. ## Make Dreams Real is Theme for New Rotary Year Rotarians Worldwide to Focus on At-Risk Children

There may not be a noisemaker in sight, and no verse of Auld Lang Syne echoes in anyone's head; but July 1 was indeed New Year's Day for the 1.2 million members of Rotary worldwide. The Rotary calendar begins in July, with new officers stepping into leadership roles throughout the organization, new and renewed goals set, and a fresh start to service projects at the local, district, and international levels. As Orrville Rotary welcomed incoming president Ken VanSickle and his fellow officers, Rotary International inducted Dong Kurn Lee of South Korea as leader of the organization worldwide. The first Korean to lead Rotary, Lee is chair of Bubang Co. Ltd. and Bubang Techtron Co. Ltd., manufacturing companies based in Seoul. A graduate of Yonsei University, D.K. serves as a trustee of the Busan College of Information Technology and is a 37-year member of the Seoul-Hangang Rotary Club.

During his leadership year, Lee Lee will target childhood mortality as his top area of focus. Make Dreams Real- the 2008-2009 Rotary International Theme- underscores this commitment. During his one-year term, Lee will encourage Rotary clubs around the world to partner with local governments and non-governmental organizations to initiate projects that improve literacy rates and provide sustainable sources of food and clean water to communities in developing countries. Lee points out that based on UNICEF estimates, fully two-thirds of the 9.7 million annual childhood deaths are preventable. "We will keep our minds firmly on our goal that is to save the lives of children," Lee says. "Rotary will turn the dreams of a safe and happy childhood—a childhood that becomes a long and healthy life—into a reality because all of the world's children, are our children." Lee's goals dovetail well with Rotary's ongoing commitment to the eradication of polio. Since the launch of Rotary's PolioPlus program in 1985, Rotary members have helped to immunize more than two billion children in 122 countries. On a local level, Orrville Rotary expects to nurture its own commitment to local literacy programs through the Orrville Public Library and the OrrvilleReads program as well as its relationship with the Wayne County Committee for Crippled Children & Adults & Orrville-based Central American Medical Outreach (C.A.M.O.)
