**Pictures from Home**

When your country is slightly smaller than the state of West Virginia, geography just matters more. That's why Martin Michal, Orrville Rotary's current exchange student, is quick to point out that his home country of Slovakia is located in Central- not Eastern- Europe. On Tuesday, November 18, Michal treated club members to a refresher course on his homeland, one of Europe's newer democracies. Slovakia traces its ethnic roots back to the 5th and 6th centuries when the Slavic peoples first arrived in what is now the present day Slovak Republic. Part of the Hapsburg and Austro-Hungarian empires until the end of World War I and the hybrid state of Czechoslovakia through much of the 20th Century, Slovakia

dissolved its ties amicably with the Czech Republic in 1993 and formed the modern nation of Slovakia. After joining the European Union in 2004, Slovakia today boasts the fastest growing economy in Europe.

Astride the Carpathian Mountains, Slovakia's rugged terrain is reflected in the flag and national coat of arms, which depict the three symbolic Slovak mountains Tatra, Fatra, and Matra. Skiing and ice hockey are popular, Michal adds; and many thermal springs and caverns can be found throughout the landscape. This is not a nation of huge urban centers. His home town of Zvolen has a population of 80,000, while the capital city of Bratislava is home to 450,000. Old and new exist side by side: Modern wind power technology and nuclear power are both highly developed on one hand, while on the other Slovakia is also home to more than 400 historic medieval castles. The one in Zvolen, Michal adds, dates from the 12th Century.

Michal's parents are both veterinarians, and he has two sisters at home; so getting along well with host siblings Ashton, Cora, and Grayson Wasniewski has been an easy adjustment. Asked about the highlights of his year in the U.S. to date, Martin replied that making friends in Orrville High School has been his favorite experience. And like most high school juniors, he's used to being asked the famous college question. His answer: he hopes to study law after graduation. Orrville Rotary is always on the lookout for interested host parents for its youth exchange program. Generally, Rotary students stay 3-4 months with each host family in order to experience different American lifestyles during their year in the U.S. If you have space in your home and heart for a young person from far away- or if you'd like to learn more about outbound youth exchange opportunities, contact Orrville Rotary program coordinator Jack Runion at 330-684-2402.
